# Bosch Has Record Start In NASCAR

### Bosch-sparked Toyota entries pace the 3 NASCAR series

Highlighted by the race-winning results of Toyota powered entries, Bosch is enjoying our best record ever in the three primary NASCAR series -- Sprint Cup, Nationwide Series and the Craftsman Truck Series -- in 2008.

Bosch spark plug-equipped entries have won an impressive 37 of the 56 races run through July in NASCAR racing. This includes 15 wins in the first 20 premier Sprint Cup events.



### A Gibbs Racing Toyota has taken Kyle Busch to six Nationwide Series wins.

Young Kyle Busch has been the driving force behind much of the Bosch success. The 27-year-old budding star has won a combined 16 races in the three series for Joe Gibbs Racing on Bosch. Driving Toyota Camry entries, Busch has logged eight wins in the Sprint Cup series and added six more in the Nationwide Series. He also has two more wins in Toyota Tundra trucks.



### Defending Sprint Cup champion Jimmie Johnson has brought Bosch two wins this season driving the Lowe's Chevrolet Impala for Hendrick Motorsports.

The other Toyota Cup win went to Denny Hamlin for Gibbs Racing. Bosch-equipped Hendrick Motorsports Chevrolets have taken defending Cup champion Jimmie Johnson to two wins and his teammate Dale Earnhardt, Jr. to a single victory. Kasey Kahne is a

two-time Cup winner on Bosch in a Gillett Evernham Dodge and Ryan Newman won the Daytona 500 for Penske. Tony Stewart has five Nationwide wins on Bosch and teammate Denny Hamlin has three more. Johnny Benson leads the truck series in a Toyota Tundra on Bosch.



### Veteran Johnny Benson leads the Craftsman Truck Series in points driving this Toyota Tundra pickup as Toyotas on Bosch have won seven of the first 14 races.

# More Series Titles On Tap For Bosch

## Scott Dixon pursues his 2nd IndyCar title on Bosch.

By winning five of the first 13 Indy Racing League IndyCar Series races, Scott Dixon is favored to win his second championship and bring Bosch our 12th series title.

Driving the Bosch spark plug-equipped Target Chip Ganassi Racing Dallara Honda, Dixon has a 65-point lead over Penske Racing's Helio Castroneves through July. Dan Wheldon and Ryan Briscoe have two wins each while Graham Rahal, Danica Patrick, Ryan Hunter-Reay and Tony Kanaan also won.

## Indy Lights Series features close racing on Bosch plugs.

The Indy Racing League development series - Firestone Indy Lights - is producing close racing action among young drivers on their way up the ladder to stardom running on Bosch spark plugs.

A two-car showdown is shaping up between Richard Antinucci and Raphael Matos for the title driving Bosch-sparked entries. This duo has logged two race wins each with points leader Antinucci running for Sam Schmidt Motorsports and Matos campaigning for AFS/Andretti Green.

## Audi R10 On Bosch Leads ALMS Circuit



Equipped with various Bosch racing components and systems, the Audi R10 Diesel has three overall wins in the American LeMans Series where Bosch is again dominating the LMP1 Class.



Five visits to Victory Lane this season have put Scott Dixon in the driver's seat for the '08 IndyCar Series in his Target Chip Ganassi Racing Dallara Honda on Bosch plugs.
