## Bosch Sparks 92nd Indy 500 Winner

**Scott Dixon dominates for his first victory at the Brickyard.**

Scott Dixon scored his first victory at the 92nd running of the Indianapolis to bring Bosch our 21st win in the last 22 events at this American racing classic.

The New Zealander Dixon started from the pole and drove the Bosch spark plug-equipped Target Chip Ganassi Racing Dallara Honda to a dominating win. He led 115 of the 200 laps at Indy, including the last 29 laps to win "The Greatest Spectacle In Racing."

Bosch once again dominated the Indy 500 by outfitting the entire Indy Racing League IndyCar Series field of 33 starters. Bosch has earned a winning tradition at the world's most famous race since winning the first in 1911.

Vitor Meira made a late-race charge to finish second in a Panther Racing entry, also sparked by Bosch. Young Graham Rahal, son of former Bosch

star driver Bobby Rahal, took a strong third for Newman/Haas/Lanigan Racing while Helio Castroneves was fourth for Team Penske on Bosch.

## Kasey Kahne Scores NASCAR Sweep

**Bosch-sparked Dodge takes Coke 600, All-Star Cup races.**

Kasey Kahne scored an impressive double at Charlotte Motor Speedway in late May on Bosch in NASCAR Sprint Cup racing action.

Driving a Gillett Evernham Motorsports Dodge Charger on Bosch, Kahne started with a win in the All-Star Challenge race and then came back to win the Coca-Cola 600, the NASCAR Sprint Cup's longest race of the year. Kahne became the first driver to win the All-Star non-points race after being voted into the event by the fans.

# Bosch Tops NASCAR Nationwide Series

## Joe Gibbs' Bosch-sparked Toyotas win 9 of 14 races.

Bosch spark plug-equipped Toyota Camry entries from the Joe Gibbs Racing stable are dominating the 2008 NASCAR Nationwide Series.

Gibbs Racing Toyotas have won nine of the first 14 Nationwide races this season. Veteran Tony Stewart has logged four wins for Gibbs while Kyle Busch has added three and Denny Hamlin has two more series wins. Busch totals four series wins with the fourth coming in a Toyota for Braun Racing. The young Busch has won a total of eight races for Gibbs in the three primary NASCAR racing series.

## Bosch-sparked Toyota trucks win half of the first 8 races.

Bosch spark plug-equipped Toyota Tundra pickup trucks have turned in four victories in the first eight NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series races of the '08 season.

Former series champion Todd Bodine opened the season winning at Daytona in a Germain Toyota truck. Kyle Busch added two wins driving a Billy Ballew Toyota Tundra entry. Young American driver, Scott Speed, won his first Craftsman Truck Series at Dover, DE in late May wheeling a Red Bull Toyota.
