## Best Year In NASCAR Series For Bosch

### Jimmie Johnson in line for his third straight Cup title.

With Jimmie Johnson in position to win his third consecutive Sprint Cup championship, Bosch is enjoying our finest NASCAR season in 2008.

Through October, Johnson is poised for his Cup trifecta driving his Bosch spark plug-equipped Hendrick Motorsports Chevrolet Impala. With two wins in the first six Chase races, Johnson has led in points throughout.

Bosch is dominating in all three of NASCAR's primary racing series in '08. Bosch-sparked Chevy, Dodge and Toyota entries have scored 21 Sprint Cup Series wins this season to go with another 20 Nationwide events. Toyota pickups have added 12 more Craftsmans Truck Series wins on Bosch.

## IndyCar Title To Scott Dixon

Scott Dixon won his first Indy 500, his second IndyCar Series championship and brought Bosch our 12th Indy Racing League IndyCar Series title in 2008.

Driving a Dallara Honda V8 for Target Chip Ganassi Racing, Dixon scored six

wins and had 13 top-three finishes for his second series title following his first crown in 2003. Bosch won another Indy Racing League crown by again sparking all the Honda V8 entries in the first unified season for the IRL.

# More Titles For Teams On Bosch

## Ganassi team tops again in Grand American DP series

Chip Ganassi Racing delivered another Grand American Rolex Sports Car Series title for Bosch in the '08 season.

The driving duo of Scott Pruett and Memo Rojas won six races, including three of the first four events, for Ganassi's second title since 2004.

Bosch once again dominated this popular road racing series winning all 14 DP Class events. Bosch became the official supplier of Engine Control Units and other components in 2007.

## 38th straight road racing title for teams on Bosch

In addition to the Grand-Am crown, another American LeMans Series title resulted in an unprecedented 38th consecutive season of road racing championships turned in on Bosch in the 2008 campaign.

Bosch again supplied racing spark plugs and a wide range of other components for the ALMS entries. This resulted in a winning sweep of all four classes of the series. The Audi R10 won the LMP1 Class and Porsche repeated in LMP2 while Corvette swept GT1 and a Porsche took GT2.
